### In alphabetical order:

<u>colour</u>	how "color" is spelled in Britain and Canada
<u>coloured</u>	how "colored" is spelled in Britain and Canada
<u>compelled</u>	forced or driven to an action
<u>depot</u>	a place where military recruits are gathered for classification, training, and assignment to active units
<u>distinguished</u>	known by being excellent; eminent; famous
<u>freedmen</u>	people who became free from a bondage such as slavery
<u>garrison</u>	to occupy with troops; to assign to a military post
<u>prejudice</u>	bias, intolerance
<u>principle</u>	meant as "principal" meaning main or important
<u>Province</u>	country, here referring to Canada
<u>reference</u>	a source of information or recommendation, for example a reference for a job
<u>regiment</u>	a military unit made up of a number of battalions, or groups of soldiers
